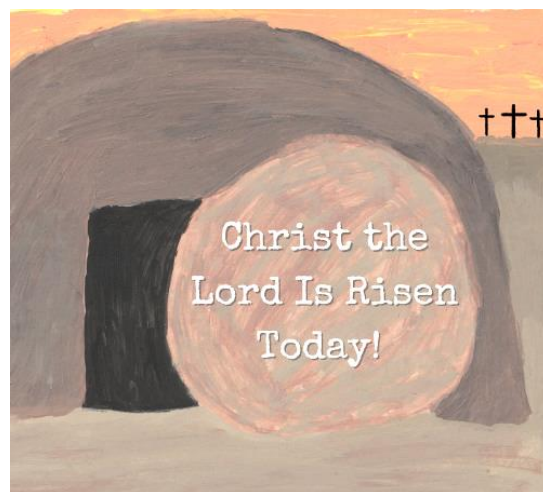

EASTER: A TOWERING FEAST

Beginning with the Easter Triduum as its source of light, the new age of the Easter Resurrection fills the whole liturgical year with its brilliance. Former New York City Cardinal, Timothy Dolan, preached that, *"Easter is not simply one feast among others, but the 'Feast of feasts, the towering feast of the entire Church liturgical year."* In fact, Dolan continues, *"The Easter feast is spread out over a period of 50 days: an 8-day Easter Octave; 40-day period Jesus remained on earth until his Ascension; 50 days until the arrival of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost."* Thus, the 50-day Easter season is the penultimate Christian celebration and the heart of our Catholic faith. Belief in the Resurrection leads directly to the belief that we, too, are destined for eternal life. Catholic churches cry out during the Easter feast, *"Jesus Christ is risen today, Alleluia!"*
