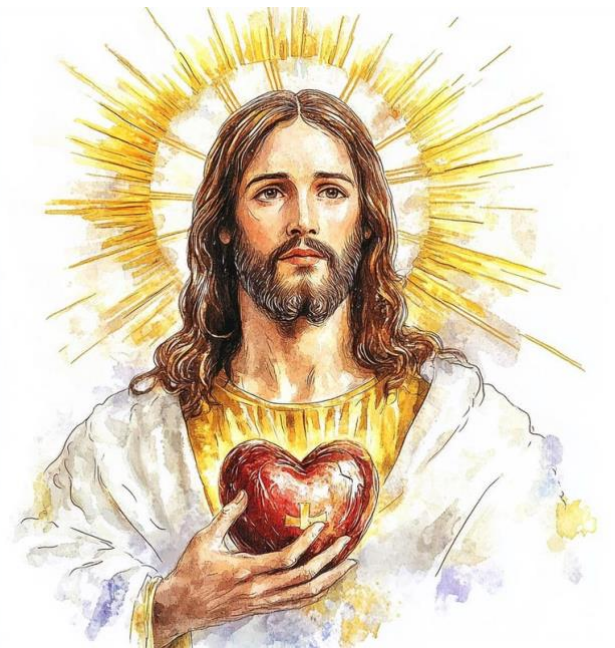

## The Sacred Heart of Jesus

The Church sets aside June as the month especially dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the feast to the Sacred Heart celebrated each June 12. While reflections on the heart of Jesus date to the earliest writings of Christianity, the modern devotion to the Sacred Heart began in 17th century France when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received visions of Jesus revealing his heart burning with love for humanity. In this revelation, Jesus expressed his desire to be honored in a special way through his Sacred Heart. The devotion grew when Pope Pius IX extended the observance to the universal Church in 1856, and later when St. Mary of the Divine Heart of Jesus urged Pope Leo XIII to consecrate the world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, which he did in 1899 through his encyclical, *"Annum Sacrum (on consecration to the Sacred Heart)"*. In his prayer intention for June 2026, Pope Leo XIV encourages us, *"Let us pray together that each one of us might find consolation in a personal relationship with Jesus, and from His Heart, learn to have compassion on the world."*
